Host First Nation Charitable Casino Policy Amendments

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This bulletin is to advise Host First Nation charities of **IMPORTANT AMENDMENTS** to the Host First Nation Charitable Casino Policies Handbook (HFNCCPH).

These following HFNCCPH policies are effective May 2, 2016:

Section 1.8 Deal Us In Casino Staff Training
(Previously named Responsible Gambling Training)

- Section 1.8 has been renamed and content reorganized into a more cohesive manner that will assist Host First Nation charities to better understand Deal Us In Casino Staff Training requirements.
- Subsections 1.8.7 b) and 1.8.8 are **NEW** requirements for Host First Nation charities. Effective immediately, Host First Nation charities are required to:
 - ensure at least one (1) Deal Us In Phase One certified staff member is on shift at all times; and
 - keep a log of employees who are Deal Us In certified, including the employees' names, certificate registration numbers and expiry dates. This log is subject to review by the AGLC.

Please familiarize yourself with the revised policies and update your HFNCCPH with the amended policies as required and ensure all affected staff are notified of the new requirements.
